Eugene Romaniuk was admitted to the New South Wales Bar in September 1994 and commenced private practice in February 1995. Eugene completed university study at the Australian National University in 1992 and obtained Bachelor of Laws (First Class Honours) and Bachelor of Arts degrees.

Eugene's practice involves extensive trial advocacy in fully contested hearings and he has considerable appellate experience. He regularly conducts cases against more senior practitioners, including Queen's Counsel and Senior Counsel.
